

P&C Uniform Shop Report for 9/04/2019

New Uniform Shop Co-ordinator

I'm delighted to report that Helene Hore has been the successful candidate in becoming the new Uniform Shop Co-ordinator. This position is now a paid position, we have commenced a handover which is progressing well.

Lost Property Tag

Ragtagd the company who supplies and stitches in the lost property tags for the jackets and hats are now only providing the service to schools whose jackets are supplied by the company 'Spartan'. They are no longer providing the service at all in regards to hats.

The Uniform Shop reviewed a sample jacket from Spartan and found it to be of inferior quality to our existing jacket. Over the last year 290 families have got their items returned using this service. I don't know what percentage of that number are the same family who use the service more than once. Of those who do use the service, they were surveyed by Ragtagd and reported that they were happy with the service. A conversation is needed with the P&C to look at options.

Curiously, Ragtagd have also asked if they can be invited to a P&C meeting to see if we may be interested in a technological solution that would allow P&Cs to run a uniform shop with a significantly reduced administrative/business burden by placing sensors on the roof of the uniform shop that can provide real time 100% accurate stock counts. See email correspondence to P&C – again this requires further discussion.
